Course Descriptions

Adult Track

Fall Prevention in the Community: Evidence-Based Best Practices

Daniel Swiatek, OTR/L is an occupational therapist with 20 years of experience in acute care, skilled nursing, and home health. Dan currently is a regional clinical director for Genesis Rehabilitation Services.

Course Description: This presentation is an overview of evidence-based interventions for occupational therapy practitioners to address falls management, with an emphasis on home safety and assessments for high-risk populations.

Fortifying Resiliency in Adults and Seniors

Kathy Khalsa, CPC, OTR/L is currently the Supervisor of the Senior Behavioral Health Unit at Oro Valley Hospital in the NW Tucson area.

Course Description: Resiliency helps us weather the storms that life brings including loss, pain, and disappointments. Everyday challenges might be dealing with the loss of function or role; pain in the body and/or spirit and the disappointment of no longer being able to do what matters to us most. Oftentimes, as occupational therapists, this is exactly what we see our patients and clients confronting. Specific resiliency factors that can be fostered, facilitated and easily incorporated in OT evaluations and treatment sessions will be reviewed and discussed in this presentation.

National Shifts, Opportunities to Support Adults with Developmental Disabilities, and Business Continuity

Christopher Trujillo, OTD, OTR/L, GCG, ATP is an Assistant Clinical Professor at Northern Arizona University's Occupational Therapy Doctoral program at the Phoenix Biomedical Campus.

Antwan D. Davis has a Master's in Public Administration and currently functions as Operations Manager for ResCare Residential Services overseeing operations throughout Arizona.

Jason Morgan owns Strategic Business Integration Services, offering business strategy consulting, merger & acquisition advisory services, capacity building, exit planning, and business startup services.

Course Description: There are approximately 123,000 working aged adults with developmental disabilities (DD) living in Arizona and only 33% of these individuals are gainfully employed. In this session, participants will learn how occupational therapy traditionally fits within government and funding systems and how policy shifts affecting individuals with DD are actually opportunities for occupational therapists to provide innovative solutions for adults with DD. This session will encourage occupational therapists to discover alternative strategies and funding sources that will improve employment outcomes for adults with DD.

Telehealth and Occupational Therapy

Nancy Rowe is associate director for outreach at the Arizona Telemedicine Program. She has more than 15 years of telemedicine experience, including directing a telepsychiatry network.

Tammy Richmond, MS, OTR/L, FAOTA is the CEO of Go 2 Care, a telehealth company and the Chair of the American Telemedicine Association Telerehab Special Interest Group.

Course Description: Competency in utilizing telehealth technologies for delivering care is important to protect the consumer and to demonstrate critical decision-making and skills needed for quality of care standards. This session will provide an overview of telehealth in general, current regulations and reimbursement in Arizona and nationally, technology, training opportunities, and additional resources. The clinical presentation will reflect the current best practices standards available today, including resources and references to standards and guidelines, official documents, service models and case examples in telerehabilitation and telehealth.

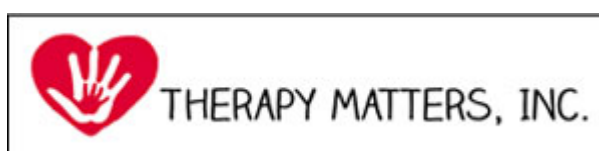
Pediatric Track
